

About Iran (Economical)

Iran's economy is characterized by its hydrocarbon, agricultural, and service sectors, as well as a noticeable state presence in the manufacturing and financial services. Iran ranks second in the world for natural gas reserves and fourth for proven crude oil reserves. While relatively diversified for an oil exporting country, economic activity and government revenues still rely on oil revenues and have, therefore, been volatile. A new five-year development plan is under preparation. The previous plan for 2016/17 to 2021/22 comprised three pillars: the development of a resilient economy, progress in science and technology, and the promotion of cultural excellence. Among its priorities were the reform of state-owned enterprises and the financial and banking sectors, and the allocation and management of oil revenues. The plan envisioned annual economic growth of 8%.

About Iran (Economical)

Over the last two years, Iran's economy has started to rebound, supported by a recovery in services post-pandemic, increased oil sector activity, and accommodating policy action. Economic activity has also adjusted to sanctions, including through exchange rate depreciation which helped domestically produced tradable goods to become price competitive internationally. The decline in oil exports has prompted additional processing of crude oil and hydrocarbons that have then been exported as petrochemicals. Under sanctions, trade has pivoted further towards neighboring countries and **China**, and bilateral currency exchange, barter, and other indirect payment channels are increasingly used to settle international transactions as most assets abroad have become inaccessible due to sanctions. The government expanded cash transfers and subsidies to mitigate the impact of high inflation on welfare, but this also added to fiscal pressures as most interventions were not sufficiently targeted.

Life expectancy index

Now the report of the World Bank shows that the life expectancy of the people of Iran has increased since the beginning of the revolution, it has increased by 25 years and has reached more than 76 years.

Reducing mortality from infectious diseases

The row mortality index in Iran according to statistics has decreased from 1.3 percent to 0.5 percent recently.

Increasing the number of hospitals and medical centers

The number of medical and hospitals has increased from 37% to more than 95% all over the provinces in Iran since 1979. According to the statistics the number of active hospital's beds reached to 160,000.

Growth in the number of doctors and health professionals

In 1956 due to the lack of sufficient number of Iranian doctors, healthcare system required overseas doctors. Nowadays, with a population of around 83 million, healthcare and medical industry growth increasingly and we have 16 doctors per 10,000 people in Iran. Proudly we are hosting big number of medical tourists from neighbors countries.








The growth of universities of medical sciences

In 1957, the total number of doctors with medical system cards was about 17 thousand, while in the past years, about 140 thousand doctors were trained in medical sciences universities across the country. The outstanding growth in the number of medical sciences universities in all provinces of the country has increased. Additionally the percentage of graduated medical students, specially for women, reached to the highest level.

INDEX & Facts

- Iran healthcare spending in 2021 was \$0, a 100% decline from 2020. Iran healthcare spending for 2020 was \$573, a 27.25% increase from 2019. Iran healthcare spending for 2019 was \$451, a 2.61% decline from 2018.
- The health status values for Iran were 75.62 for life expectancy at birth, 9.32 for NMR, 15.02 for U5MR, and 15.3 for the probability of dying from CVDs, cancer, diabetes, or CRD; and 0.96 for mortality rate attributed to exposure to unsafe WASH.
